Time: 10:00-14:15



Important Information when reporting an Emergency

REMAIN CALM

Ensure to give a <u>Clear Description</u> of the incident you are reporting Give your <u>Name and Surname</u> clearly

Give your Contact Telephone Number clearly

Give your Exact Location - name of company, street name,

Take the name of the person to whom you are reporting the incident and time you reported the incident
