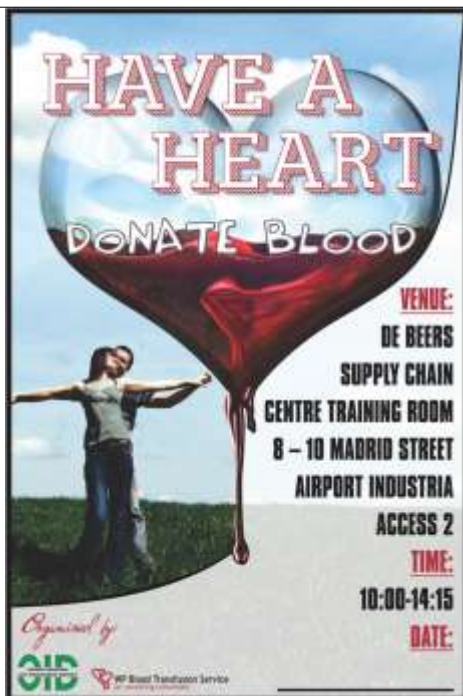

Forms have been delivered to the CID office, which the donors can complete on the morning of the donation, before arriving at the clinic. This will reduce the amount of time away from work. Please advise on the number of employees who will donate blood, to divide the companies into groups and prevent too many people attending at once and keeping workers away from work for too long.

Thank you for having the heart to support this needy and worthy cause. Thank You to the people who have throughout the year supported this project.



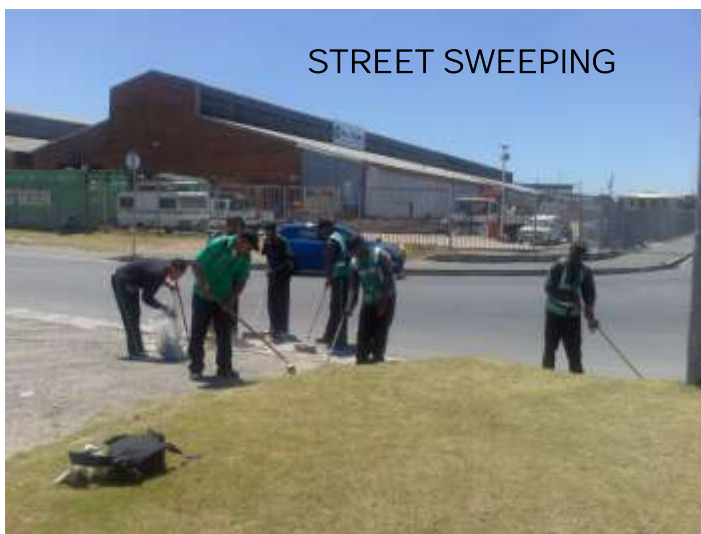
Essential Cleaning Services

REMAIN CALM

Ensure to give a Clear Description of the incident you are reporting

Give your Name and Surname clearly

Give your Contact Telephone Number clearly

Give your Exact Location - name of company, street name,

Take the name of the person to whom you are reporting the incident and time you reported the incident
