The Airport CID has made an application for the approval for the Airport CID to implement its Business Plan as from 1 July 2015 to 30 June 2020 (as per Annexure A).

The Airport CID held an AGM on 4 December 2014 to communicate with its members on specific criteria and to obtain their support to implement the Business Plan.

The notice of the AGM indicates that the activities of the current year will be reviewed and also the planning for the ensuing year. It informs property owners regarding the right to membership if they wish to participate and vote at Airport CID meetings. It further indicates that the relevant documents are available on the website.

The notice of the AGM was advertised in the daily newspapers and sent to the property owners.

The Airport CID Business Plan (1 July 2015 to 30 June 2020) was supported and approved unanimously by the members of Airport CID at the AGM held on 4 December 2014, as per Annexure B.

No objections were received.

The Business Plan, consists of the Motivation Plan indicating that the same services will be provided, the Implementation Plan proposing relevant action steps to implement the services and the 5 year Budget that proposed a term increase of 20.9% with a year on year increase of 10%. Refer to the 5 year budget within the Business Plan (Annexure A).

The application complies with the SRA Policy and By-Law – the property owners were consulted, and the Airport CID Business Plan was approved unanimously at the AGM.
